


## NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

### A report on “Health Check-up Camp”

The NSS Unit of **ATME College of Engineering**, in association with **Bhagwan Mahaveer Darshan Eye Hospital, Mysuru**, successfully organized a **Health Check-up Camp** as part of **NSS Day** on **24th September 2025** from **9:30 AM to 4:00 PM** at the **Administrative Block** of the college premises.



The health camp included **Eye Check-up, Ear Test, and Dental Check-up** services provided by a team of qualified doctors and medical staff. A large number of students, teaching faculty, and non-teaching staff actively participated in the camp and availed themselves of the medical facilities. Eye examinations helped in identifying vision-related problems and the need for corrective measures, while ear tests assisted in detecting hearing-related issues. Dental check-ups focused on oral hygiene, early detection of dental problems, and preventive care.

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The medical professionals also offered valuable guidance on maintaining eye care, ear hygiene, and oral health. Participants were educated on the importance of regular health check-ups for early diagnosis, prevention of serious health conditions, and timely medical intervention.

The camp was well coordinated by the NSS volunteers, who ensured smooth registration, crowd management, and assistance to the medical team. The program created awareness about health and hygiene and reinforced the spirit of social responsibility among students.
