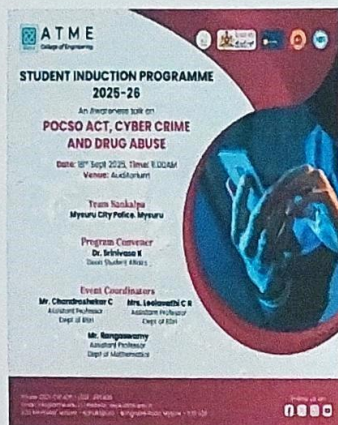

Report on Awareness Program on POCSO Act, Cyber Crime and Drug Abuse
