Report on CATALYST 2025

The Department of Civil Engineering, ATME College of Engineering, Mysuru, organized the Preliminary Written Test of **Catalyst–2025**, a Civil Engineering Quiz Programme conducted in association with the Association of Consulting Civil Engineers (India), Mysore Centre and sponsored by SK Super TMT Steel.

The objective of the programme was to enhance technical knowledge, promote competitive spirit, and provide a platform for final year / 7th semester Civil Engineering students to showcase their academic excellence.

The preliminary written test was conducted on **13th November 2025 at 11:00 AM** in the respective institutions. The duration of the test was **30 minutes**, and all questions were compulsory. There was no negative marking. Based on performance in the written test, five teams were shortlisted from ATME College of Engineering to participate in the final round.
